Mayor & Council: Mayor Newton and Councilmember Olney

- Mayor Newton announces “Rockville Goes Purple” event with City Police.
- Question as to what to do in Emergency situations, when the electric goes out (Power outages). Go to Senior Center, Richard Montgomery High School.
- February 4th Mayor & Council had guest speakers from Laurel for Emergency Management and work session with Mayor of Laurel. Preparedness needs training and conversations for all kinds of emergency at the Swim Center, Fitness center, and Senior center.
- Councilmember Julie Palakovich Carr left the City Council, January 8th, leaving the four remaining councilmembers to interview new candidates and to fill the seat. Applications will be available online. Interviews will be shown on the Rockville channel 11. Deadline February 22nd, interviews will be held on March 2 and 5th.
- 2024 will be a starting point for developing a “History Park”, renovating Isreal Park.
