Rape /arrest by Metro by Special Victim Unit (Zimmerman lives in Gaithersburg but aggression occurred near Rockville metro).

Complaints from business owners on Stonestreet avenue, Southlawn avenue and East Gude for offenses such as drinking, urinating in public, marijuana/cocaine sales. The District Committee Action Plan is taking complaints.

## City Police, Bob Rappoport:

Disorderly conducts on First street and Lincoln Park, after Lincoln Park forever event. Harassment of kids in Maryvale Park. Three persons arrested, charged with robbery (bike stolen) and second-degree assault. Kids were about 17 years old, assailants were 28 years old and over.

Issues reported by members of community: robocalls, cars parked on Stonestreet and Frederick avenue, day and night, tow-truck in front of Lincoln High school.
